The Board meets approximately 4 times a year in addition to regular email contact. We ask that members commit to a minimum term of 1 year.

### **About the Lakeshore Grounds Interpretive Centre**

The Lakeshore Grounds Interpretive Centre aims to research, preserve, and share the natural and built heritage of the Lakeshore Grounds region of South Etobicoke and to engage both the Humber College and Etobicoke Lakeshore communities through a mix of cultural and arts-based exhibitions and cultural programming. We focus primarily on themes of Indigenous heritage, mental health, education, and environmental sustainability.

The Lakeshore Grounds Interpretive Centre is operated by Humber College, under the collaborative management of the Principal's Office, Lakeshore campus and the Faculty of Social and Community Services.
